Dear Parishioners, The Archbishop of Westminster, Cardinal Vincent Nichols announced the news in a statement: "I am writing to let you know the sad news that Cardinal Cormac Murphy-O'Connor died peacefully on Friday 1st September 2017 surrounded by family and friends. Please pray for the repose of his soul." The funeral rites for His Eminence Cardinal Cormac Murphy-O'Connor have been arranged for Tuesday 12th September with the Reception of the Body at 10.00 am and Solemn Vespers of the Dead at 5.00 pm. On Wednesday 13th September at 12 noon there will be a Funeral Mass followed by a burial at Westminster Cathedral. Prayer cards are available from the back of church.
