DROITWICH SPA FOODBANK 2018/2019 REPORT

We have just completed our year-end and would like to thank everyone who has either placed an item in our collection boxes or made a cash donation; without you we would not be able to help the people in our community who have found themselves in a desperate situation. Between April 2018 and March 2019 we fed 2189 people of which 833 were children. This is an increase of 34% on the previous year. The most concerning trend is the increase in families who have sought our help. Most clients come to us because of delays in benefits, changes in benefits or low income and they are referred to us by agencies such as the job centre, Age UK, Fortis housing, doctors, social workers and schools. Last year we had 17,800 kg of food and toiletries donated by people who live in and around Droitwich, people like you who take time to put a tin in a box. Thank you so much.

REFUGEE ITEMS

Thank you so much for the exquisite knitted and crocheted items donated this month. Also, once again a special thank you to the ladies who sent in the gorgeous blankets, scarf and glove sets and packaged them so beautifully. Also another very special thank you to the ladies who regularly knit such vast quantities of beautiful hats and scarves. These items will be so treasured by the people in the camps. As mentioned previously there will be no May collection; please keep knitting for the collection on Saturday 1st June.
