Let us pray for all key workers and healthcare workers, especially among our family and friends.

Let us pray for those who are sick or in any need: those we know and those who have nobody to pray for them.

Let us pray for those who have died in recent days and weeks and for their families:

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.

Let us ask for the prayers and protection of Mary, Our Mother, as we say: Hail Mary...

Let us pray that God's will may be done in our lives, as we say: Our Father...

For all of God's blessings to us as a family, we pray: Glory be to the Father...
