## **C**RITERIA FOR A TRUSTEE

- To attend and actively participate in meetings of the Trustees (typically three times a year, held in the evening either face-to-face or virtually).
- To have an interest in relieving poverty, especially food poverty, the work of Foodbanks in this regard and in Droitwich Spa and its surrounding areas.
- To be aware of the distinction between governance and management and be able to act as a critical friend to those managing DSFB.
- To be a team player and positive role model to all those connected with DSFB, including its clients and its partners.
- To contribute to the need to adapt to the increased demand faced by the Droitwich Spa Foodbank, particularly in scaling up of the management of the Foodbank warehouse and managing volunteers.
- To possess particular skills and experiences complementary to other Trustees, which may involve finance & fundraising; property; public relations/media/social media; managing volunteers and fund raising; social policy, particularly in relation to poverty alleviation.
- 7 To be an articulate, compassionate advocate in a variety of forums and in manners appropriate to the audience.
- To be a practicing Christian, or to be fully supportive Droitwich Foodbank's Christian ethos to feed the poor and hungry (e.g. Matthew 25:34-40).
