Census 2021 is coming! Have you got your census letter?

The census is a once-in-a-decade survey which ensures everyone from local government to charities can put services and funding in the places where they are most needed such as doctors' surgeries, schools and new transport routes.

Census day is on Sunday 21 March, but households will now be receiving letters with online codes explaining how they can complete their forms. Paper questionnaires will be available for those who need them.

There's a wide range of support services such as

language support and accessible census guidance. You can also get help from census staff in the contact centre over phone, in a web chat or on social media.


Join in this weekend! Annual Guild of St Stephen Mass
