Reporting to the Diocesan Solicitor/Data Compliance Co-ordinator, the Data Compliance Manager will monitor compliance and data practices internally to ensure the business and its functions comply with the applicable requirements under the UK GDPR and relevant national legislation.

The Data Compliance Manager will also be responsible for advising on, and where required carrying out, training for post holders, staff and volunteers, data protection impact assessments and internal audits.

To undertake this role, you will need:

- Significant experience in privacy compliance.
- Experience in developing policy and compliance training.
- Experience in system management, including IT and traditional systems, and
- Significant knowledge of European and UK data privacy and data protection regulation.

You should also have hold at least one data protection and/or privacy certification, such as CIPP, CIPT, CIPM, or the ISEB.
