The role, by appointment of Archbishop Bernard Longley, has been vacant following the death of Canon Gerry Breen in December 2019.

Initial preparations are already underway for the Diocesan Lourdes Pilgrimage 2022, which will hopefully see a return to the holy site.

Fr Jeremy is currently parish priest at Our Lady of Lourdes in Hednesford, Staffordshire, which is home to the Diocesan shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes.

He has been there for four years and hosts the annual Hednesford Pilgrimage in July.
