

### Diocese of Westminster - "Behold Your Mother"

Over two years, from 2018-2020, the renowned Statue of Our Lady of Walsingham visited every Catholic Cathedral in England with a mission to pray for the Re-evangelisation and Conversion of England. This led to the great Rededication of England as the Dowry of Mary on March 29th 2020.

It was a moment of grace when Catholics in England were invited to renew their own personal "YES" to the Lord Jesus through acts of Consecration to Jesus through Mary. These Acts of Consecration were prayed along side the great Rededication Prayer of England as the Dowry of Mary, prayed by every English Bishop from his own Diocesan Cathedral with priests and faithful from their own parishes and homes.

The plans for the Rededication were turned upside down due to the Covid-19 Pandemic. Nevertheless it was a day of extraordinary Grace which only upon reaching heaven will we all understand. Yet there is much that was left unfinished. Not least the final Dowry Tour of Our Lady of Walsingham to Westminster Cathedral.
