### Pastoral Letter: The Synod 2021 - 2023

This weekend a Pastoral Letter on the Diocesan response to the recently launched Synod will be read out in churches.

The overall theme is '*For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission*'.

A Mass to mark the Opening of the Synodal Pathway in the Archdiocese of Birmingham will take place at St Chad's Cathedral on Sunday 17 October, celebrated by Archbishop Bernard Longley. **All are welcome to join via the Cathedral live stream.**

The work to be undertaken across the Archdiocese during the Synodal process will be done in conjunction with the ongoing implementation of the *Diocesan Vision, Unfolding God's Plan*.

Ahead of the Assisted Dying Bill which is due to receive its Second Reading, with full debate, on Friday 22 October there is a national novena seeking the intercession of St John Paul II, on whose feast the Second Reading falls.

It started yesterday and runs until 22 October.

The Novena Prayer:

Merciful God, we pray with thanks and gratitude for the great spiritual gift of Saint John Paul II's apostolic life and mission. Through his heavenly intercession we ask that the 'Assisted Dying' Bill be defeated and that the infinite worth of each human person is upheld through proper investment in palliative care. Grant also that we may grow in love for You and proclaim boldly the love of Jesus Christ to all people. Through Christ, Our Lord. Amen.

The Annual Intercultural Mass is back and will be celebrated at St Osburg's Church, Coventry, so linking




to Coventry's designation as "City of Culture" this year and marking One World Week and World Mission Sunday.
