Covid-19 update

The latest guidance for churches regarding Covid-19 has been issued by the Catholic Bishops' Conference, with effect from Thursday 27 January.

The restrictions placed on public worship and the celebration of Mass, social activities and home visits have been reduced considerably.

The Archdiocese joined forces with the Medaille Trust to launch a six-year Look Up awareness campaign in February 2019, to work together to combat modern slavery in our communities.

This partnership is now being relaunched at a special online event on the feast day of St Josephine Bakhita, Patron Saint of Victims of Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking.

All are invited to join the relaunch to hear about modern slavery in the West Midlands, how Medaille Trust are supporting victims and survivors and what you and your congregation can do to help.

The event takes place on **Tuesday 8 February from 6pm to 7pm**.
