- Fit a key safe.
- Move & assemble furniture.
- Fix toilet seats.
- Fit grab and stair rails.
- Carry out security checks.
- Change light bulbs.
- Secure loose carpets/rugs.
- Provide non-slip bathmats

Where we cannot do a particular task, we signpost to our trusted directory. The service and equipment are funded by the CCG and provided free of charge.
