A second collection to support those seeking safety in the Archdiocese from Ukraine

Many parish communities in our Archdiocese have already been most generous in their support – financial and through prayer - for those who are suffering because of the war in Ukraine.

Archbishop Bernard has asked parishes to hold a second collection on or around the **14/15 May 2022** to support our ability to respond to the many needs connected with this work of welcome.

We have already seen, in St Chad's Sanctuary, many Ukrainian families coming for support as they have not yet received a destitution fund. Our Ukrainian communities in Wolverhampton and Coventry have held successful orientation and community events for Ukrainian refugees. We want to expand this work and support across the Diocese.
