New Vice Rector for Oscott College

Fr Michael Dolman, Rector of St Mary's College, Oscott is delighted to announce that Fr Andrew Allman is the new Vice Rector.

Fr Andrew, of Lancaster Diocese, will take up his appointment on Wednesday 3 August. He is currently the parish priest at St Clare's, Preston and the chaplain at the Royal Preston Hospital.

St Mary's College, Oscott, the seminary of the Archdiocese of Birmingham, forms men for the priesthood from 15 dioceses in England, Wales and Scotland, as well as Religious Congregations. It also prepares men for ministry as permanent deacons for five dioceses.

Fr Andrew takes over from Fr Paul Keane, who has been appointed as Catholic Chaplain to the University of Cambridge.
