The 108th World Day of Migrants and Refugees 2022 is celebrated on 25 September - the last Sunday of the month. The Holy Father has chosen the theme 'Building the Future with Migrants and Refugees'.

The Church has been celebrating the World Day of Migrants and Refugees (WDMR) since 1914. It's always an occasion to express concern for different vulnerable people on the move; to pray for them as they face many

challenges; and to increase awareness about the opportunities that migration offers.

Oscott Lectures: Neighbours Without Borders

The title "Neighbours without borders" comes from Pope Francis' encyclical letter Fratelli Tutti - On Fraternity and

Social Friendship, 80). Reflecting on the globalised world of today, he notes that “the sense of belonging to a single human family is fading” and yet it is “the culture of encounter...which is the way to restore hope and bring about renewal” (FT, 30).

This series of evening lectures to be held at **Oscott College in November** explores the role of the Church and dialogue in building such a culture of encounter in service to humanity.
