A day of reflection with talks on Hidden Catholicism by Jan Graffius from Stonyhurst and the persecution of Christians in the present day by Dr Caroline Hull, National Director of Aid to the Church in Need.

Enjoy private tours of the Hall and an opportunity to see recusant items from Stonyhurst as well as items from areas of current persecution of Christians.

The day will finish with a procession of the Blessed Sacrament from the Hall to the church and Mass celebrated by Bishop David Evans.




Blessing of Graves at Oscott Cemetery
