About us

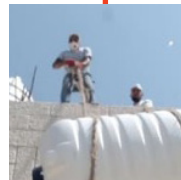
Friends of the Holy Land's mission is to secure a resilient and enduring community for Christians in the birthplace of Christianity.

By providing practical help to our most vulnerable Christian brothers and sisters in the West Bank, Gaza, Israel, and Jordan, we strive to create a sustainable future in the Holy Land – a future filled with God's hope.

The funds we raise are used to relieve emergency needs and support practical long-term projects. This helps the Christian community in the Holy Land to not only survive but thrive.

We have a team of local lay and clerical professionals who identify and verify our cases, and our work is proudly ecumenical. Our supporters in the UK come from all denominations of the Christian Faith who help our mission by:

- 1. Raising awareness:** of the challenges faced by Christians in the Holy Land
- 2. Prayer:** we encourage prayer on their behalf
- 3. Fund Raising:** we generate funds to provide practical help
- 4. Pilgrimage:** we encourage visits to the Holy Land to meet local Christians.



Our work

Education

In the Holy Land, high-quality education comes at a price. Helping children gain a private Christian education gives them the best start.

Employment

Having a secure livelihood changes everything. We sponsor work placements for young people; provide seed funding to assist Christian business ventures; help fund vocational training qualifications in trades; and supporting the traditional Christian industry of Olive Wood carving.

Health

There is no NHS or other social care to fall back on in the West Bank when you need urgent medical care. Vulnerable families need help to pay hospital fees or buy ongoing medication for chronic conditions.

Housing Improvements

Many Christian families are living without a clean water supply due to the frequent water shortages. Also living in unhealthy and unsuitable conditions they cannot afford to renovate.

Family Support Programme

A helping hand in times of need to the most vulnerable families in the Bethlehem area. This programme grants a regular sum of NIS 1500 per quarter (approx. £4 per day) to these most needy families to support their basic needs - food, medicine, rent, or utilities.
