## Youth Group Church Tours Frequently Asked Questions

We welcome visiting groups. We have tried to answer the most commonly asked questions from our visitors below. Ideally groups should be at least 10 people.

We welcome groups from children, schools and universities.

### **When can we visit?**

Guided tours of the Church are available for groups. Please note that tours are only available on weekdays (excluding Wednesdays and Bank Holidays) after Morning Mass from 10am and before 6pm. Please note that it may be necessary to re-arrange at short notice if a funeral service is arranged.

### **Is there a charge for the tour?**

We do not charge for our tours, and our tour guides are volunteers. We are always happy to receive donations towards the upkeep of the church.

### **How long does a tour last?**

A tour for children normally lasts up to 45 minutes. This can be adjusted/ tailored to suit the ages and particular interests of the group. If combined with a mosaic workshop, this will be for an additional 60 minutes and often groups are split in half: one half doing the tour whilst the other half do the workshop and then swap over.

### **Accessibility**

We have a ramp access into the church and there is a hearing loop. There is also a disabled WC in the adjacent church hall.

### **Parking**

Parking is available behind the church just off College Green (WR9 8AZ)
