Church Tours Frequently Asked Questions

We welcome visiting groups. We have tried to answer the most commonly asked questions from our visitors below. Ideally groups should be at least 10 people.

We welcome groups from children, schools and universities.

When can we visit?

Guided tours of the Church are available for groups. Please note that tours are only available on weekdays (excluding Wednesdays and Bank Holidays) after Morning Mass from 10am and before 6pm. Please note that it may be necessary to re-arrange at short notice if a funeral service is arranged.

Is there a charge for the tour?

We do not charge for our tours but we do have a suggested voluntary donation of £4 per person. This can be paid in advance via the 'Donate' button on our website (select 'Mosaic Restoration'). Or on the day, in cash or by card using the 'Dona' machine at the back of church (again select 'Mosaic Restoration').

How long does a tour last?

A tour usually lasts 75-90 minutes

Accessibility

We have a ramp access into the church and there is a hearing loop. There is also a disabled WC in the adjacent church hall.

Parking

Parking is available behind the church just off College Green (WR9 8AZ)
